

# Information for Teams and Team Captains

## **What is a Team?**

A team is any group of 5 or more participants. Team members can be all ages and can be a combination of walkers and runners.

## **What am I responsible for as Team Captain?**

Team Captains are responsible for directing team members to [www.getyourrearingear.com](http://www.getyourrearingear.com) to register online under their selected team name or collecting all entry forms and fees and submitting them as a whole to the Colon Cancer Coalition no later than August 30th. Team members may be added after this date but will not impact the standing of a team for prizes. A team roster is included for Team Captains to keep track of their members. Communications from the Colon Cancer Coalition will be directed to the Team Captain.

## **Can a team collect donations?**

Absolutely! We encourage the Team and its Captain to set a fundraising goal. We ask that all donations are collected by the Team Captain and turned in on race day

In addition, donation forms are included in the team packet. Simply fill in your name and an address for pledges to be sent back to the Team Captain. We ask that all donations are collected by the Team Captain and turned in on race day.

## **When can I pick up my shirt, bib and goodie bag?**

All these items can be picked up on event day, September 6th, beginning at 2 p.m. A team captain can pick up all items for their team, but it is their responsibility to then make sure each member gets their specific items. All registration items will be under the registrant's last name, not the Team name.
